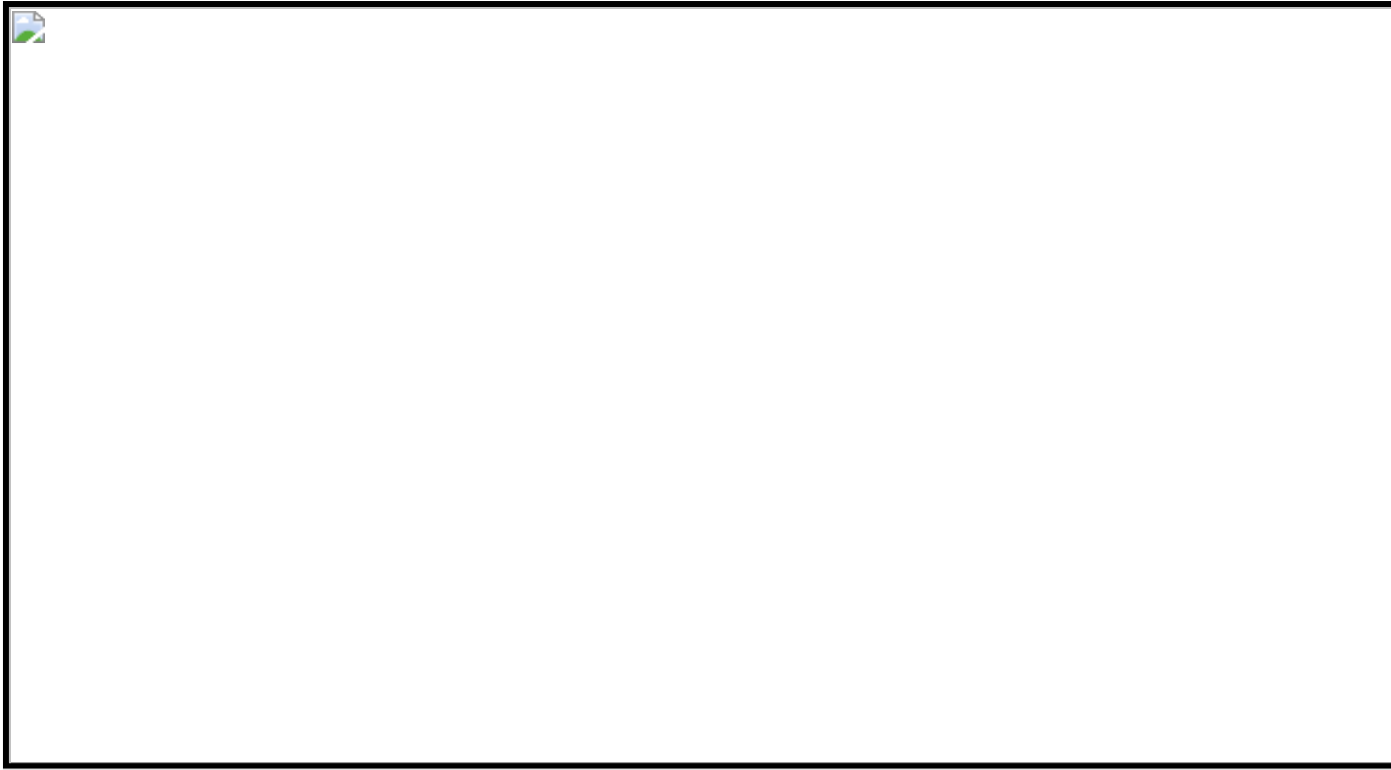
Award of Marks for listening:

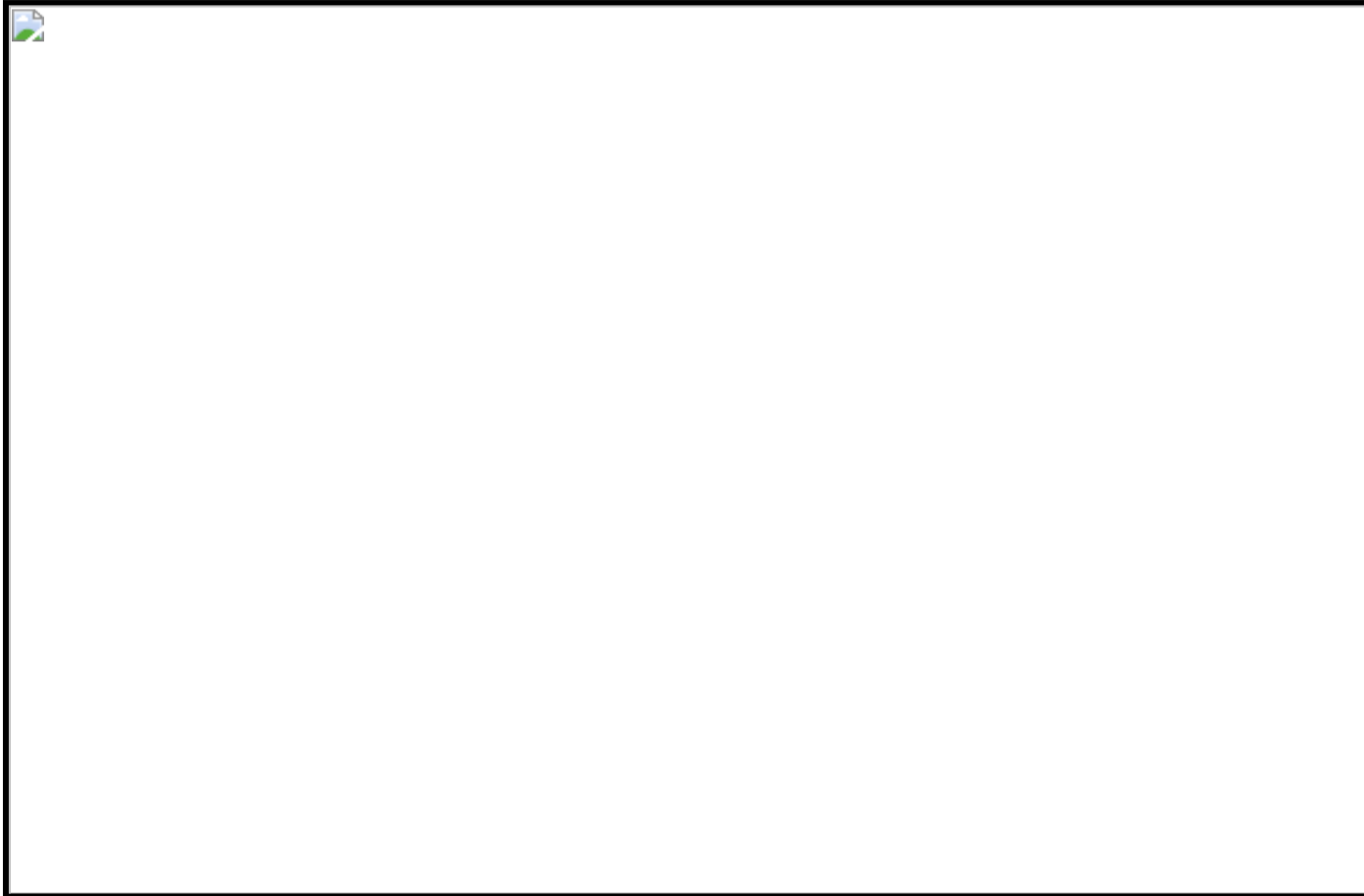
